NSGA Registration: The hotel's front desk will direct you to our Registration Desk, open from 5pm - 6pm on your arrival day. A complete welcome packet will await you with a schedule of activities, tournament rules, tee times, golf pairings, your name badge, and other important information. Handicaps will be verified at this time, so have your card ready. If you arrive late, your welcome packet will be left at the resort's front desk.

3-Day Tournament Format: The tournament will include golf for three days. Golfers will participate in a 54-hole medal play tournament utilizing the player's USGA-recognized full handicap. Prizes will be awarded to the men's, super senior men's and ladies' Overall Low Gross and Low Net winners. Long Drive and Closest to the Pin contests will be held.

Payment: **Final payment for this event is due to NSGA by March 1.** A down payment of 33% of the anticipated total is due at booking. Payment can be charged directly to any major credit card by calling NSGA at 800-282-6772. At the conclusion of the event, you will be expected to pay the resort directly for any incidental expenses incurred during your stay.

Refunds:**

A full, no-questions-asked refund is available until January 1. A partial refund is available after January 1. In January, February, March and April, the refund amount is based upon the date of cancellation, the amount that NSGA has already spent and the cause of the cancellation. These refunds may be in the form of an NSGA credit towards a future event.

Brookgreen Gardens

In 1931, Archer and Anna Hyatt Huntington founded Brookgreen Gardens, a garden museum, to preserve the native flora and fauna and display objects of art within that natural setting.

Today, Brookgreen Gardens is a National Historic Landmark with the most significant collection of figurative sculpture, in an outdoor setting, by American artists in the world, and has the only zoo accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums on the coast of the Carolinas.

Our social attendees will visit the gardens, sightsee and shop. Plus they will have lunch together.

GOLF

Caledonia Golf Course



Built upon the site of a working southern rice plantation, Caledonia has been recognized for its design and incredible beauty. Caledonia was recently ranked in Golf Magazine's "Top 100 You Can Play" and named one of "America's 100 Greatest Public Courses" by Golf Digest. Furthermore, Golfweek continues to name Caledonia as one of "America's 100 Best Modern Courses."

From the entrance lined with centuries old live oaks to its antebellum-styled clubhouse, Caledonia is a world-class experience. The 6,526-yard, par-70 course has been described as having "18 signature holes," with holes routed around majestic oaks and meandering streams. The picturesque 18th hole borders the Plantation's old rice field, and requires a precise tee shot that sets up a difficult second shot: a forced carry onto a green that is bordered by the antebellum style clubhouse.

The Dunes Golf Club

The Dunes Club golf course was built in 1948 and is recognized as one of Robert Trent Jones finest designs. Since its inception, it has proved to be a world class course, offering the best in golf and member services.

Jones changed the original course design in 1976-77 with modifications to holes 3, 4, 11, 15, and 18. Each hole has its own descriptive name to

give golfers an idea of what to expect before they tee off. "Waterloo", hole 13, is the signature hole of the Dunes Course. Famous worldwide, is a legendary hole where Lake Singleton comes into play. "Waterloo" has received every accolade and award as one of the greatest golf holes in the world.

Grande Dunes Members Club



The Members Club at Grande Dunes is a design collaboration between PGA Hall of Fame inductee, Nick Price, and golf architect, Craig Schreiner. This creative layout weaves throughout the area's natural pine preserves and along the Intracoastal Waterway, presenting a unique variety of shot-making challenges

on a gently rolling terrain. The Members Club has been voted one of the “50 Best Courses in South Carolina” by the South Carolina Golf Course Ratings Panel. This fabulous course is complemented by an elegant 27,000 square foot Italian-designed clubhouse overlooking the lake between the 9th and 18th greens plus a wonderful practice facility.
